

Decontamination Team JOB ACTION SHEET

Supervisor: Hospital/Clinic Staff

Mission: To staff the decontamination station

Qualifications: MRC Volunteer

Before ...

- Receive briefing from MRC Coordinator
- Read the current operational objectives and Incident Action Plan
- Receive briefing and Just In Time training from Hospital or Clinic staff

During ...

- Sign in on sign in sheet
- Decontamination Team Specialist
 - Assist in setting up decon tent and equipment as directed
 - Suit up in Hazmat suits
 - Assist others in donning hazmat suits
 - Decontaminate patients as trained and directed
- Nurse and Physician
 - Based on the heat and other factors, determine how long each Decontamination Team Specialist should stay in the suit.
 - Monitor Decontamination Team Specialists once they are in hazmat suits for signs of stress (including discomfort, heat exhaustion, hypertension, etc.)
 - Look for damage to suits or evidence of damage to suits
 - If needed, pull any Decontamination Team Specialists for more monitoring
 - Determine if Decontamination Team Specialist needs to take a more extended break
- Assist in setting up decontamination tent/equipment
